

## Northwood Primary School PE & Sport Premium

### Physical Education & Sports Grant 2015/16

This grant was introduced in September 2014 for all children in Primary school aged 5 years and over on the census date in January 2016. We are required to report on the impact of this funding which was £8920.

Previous year's funding has enabled the school to train a member of our school staff to take on the role as Sports Coach this year, providing quality PE to both our KS1 and KS2 pupils. Class teachers have also been able to work alongside him this year in order to improve their knowledge of the delivery of the PE curriculum.
