

# Behaviour Management Policy 2020 COVID-19 Addendum



At Northwood Primary School the expectations of our Behaviour Management Policy remain the same but it is necessary in light of the COVID-19 Pandemic to make some adjustments for the safety of all pupils and staff. Children will need to behave differently when they return to school and there will have been new routines put into place to support that. Children will therefore be expected to:

- Follow any altered routines for drop off and pick up times
- Follow school hygiene procedures for hand-washing and hand-sanitising
- Follow the “Catch it, Bin it, Kill it” approach to sneezing and coughing and use the appropriate pedal bins to dispose of tissues
- Not touch their mouth, face or eyes while at school
- Move around the school premises as instructed using one way systems, respecting out of bounds areas and social distancing whilst queuing
- Be mindful of social distancing during break and playtimes and keep a safe distance from others
- Maintain social distancing and hand hygiene when using the toilets. A discreet level of supervision will be in place
- Only use the equipment which will be provided for their personal use and their personal water bottle
- To tell an adult if they are feeling unwell or showing any symptoms e.g. high temperature, continuous cough or loss of taste and smell

**IF a child’s behaviour is deemed high risk i.e. refusing to adhere to safety measures such as hand washing, social distancing, remaining in their bubbles or deliberate behaviours that put themselves, other pupils or staff members at risk such as spitting or deliberately coughing then we reserve the right to send the child home. In these circumstances this will not necessarily be deemed an exclusion but will dependent on the individual circumstance.**
