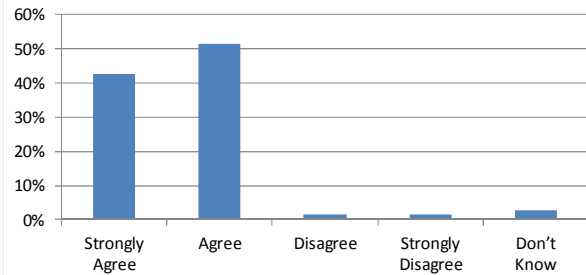
Thank you to those who took part in the recent governor feedback survey on the school.

Sixty seven families completed the form (41% of the families at Northwood) this is what you told us:

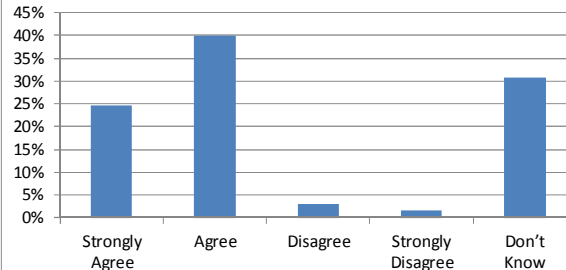

Things on which I have particular concern or would like to see improvement. 27 families commented here are the key comments/themes shown in the rough weighted order of the frequency of occurrence.

Not as much/as focussed homework as other schools. (Maths especially)	Issues of bullying /took a long time to resolve.	Limited sports focus and facilities.	Would like better resource/access to ICT.	Space and facilities for year 5 and 6.
Uniform/appearance policy should be tighter for both pupils and staff.	Golden time for year 5 and 6 is not appropriate use of time.	I would like to see more outdoor activities.	Mixed form teachers concern me especially early years.	Development days should be taken in school holiday.
Pupils should not be allowed to address teachers by Christian name.	I have road safety concerns.	More supervised reading.	Some requests for money do not represent value.	Would like more feedback.
