COVID 19

It won't have escaped your attention that we are still battling with the spread of COVID 19 within school. At the moment year 6 have been moved to remote learning until Thursday of this week. We hope that we will soon see a decline in our numbers and would like to thank you for regularly testing your children and keeping us informed. We are expecting an arrival of air cleaning units for each class (at a huge cost to the school!) and we are hoping that these will make a difference. Please take note of the following guidance: *All people – including pupils parents and teachers - have to isolate for a minimum of five full days after the day of a positive test before then going back to school if they have tested negative twice.*

The first full day of isolation is considered to be the day following the positive test. Following the fifth full day of isolation – on the sixth day - it will be possible for people who have received two negative LFD tests on consecutive days to go back to school.

People who have tested positive can now take two LFD tests on day 5 and day 6, and if both are negative and they do not have a temperature, they can end their self-isolation on day 6 and return to their education setting immediately.

International Women and Girls in Science Day

This is on **Friday 11th February** and we are hoping to have some film clips to show the children that have been made and sent in to us by women who are working in a science based career as well as learning about famous

women who have had a huge influence on the development of modern day science.
