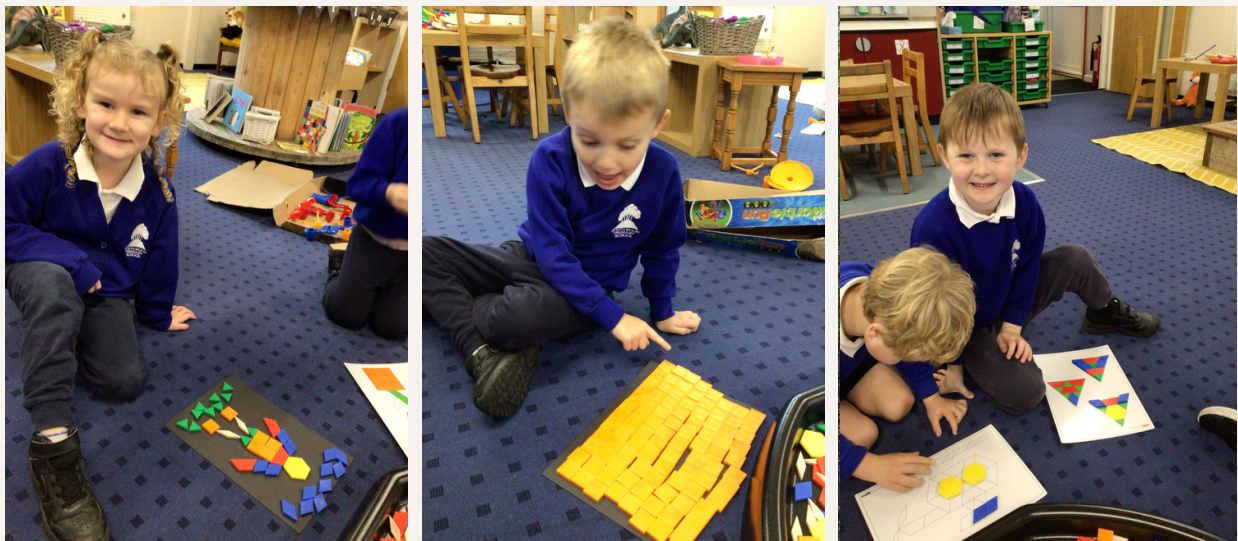


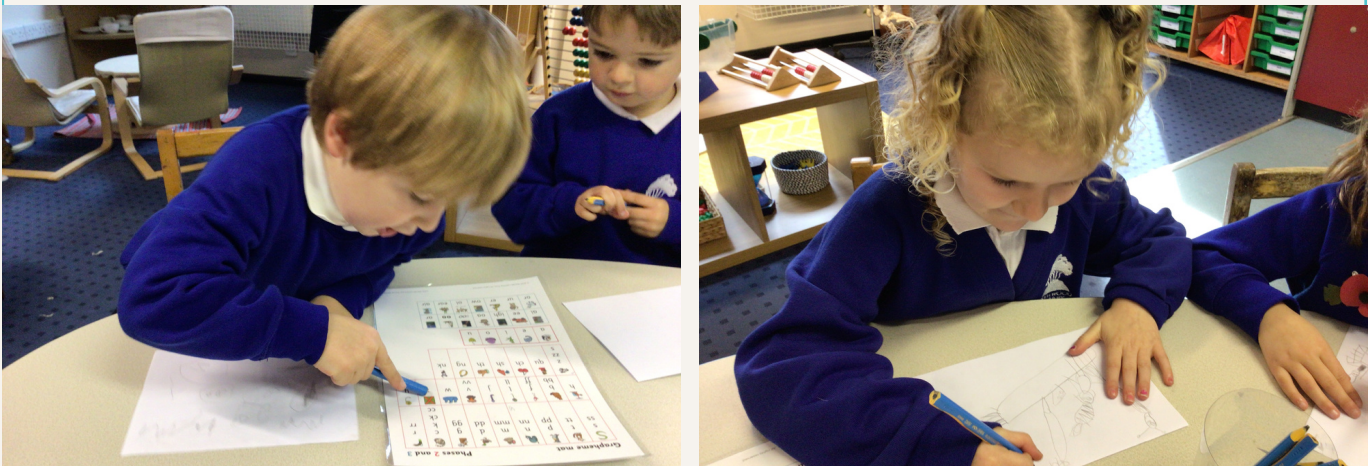


OUR ADVENTURES THIS WEEK



The Exciting Beginnings of Our Drawing Club

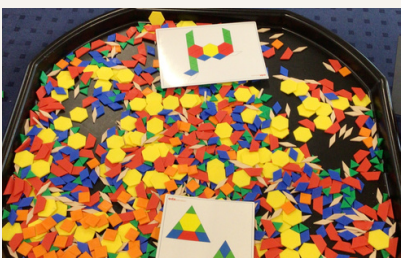

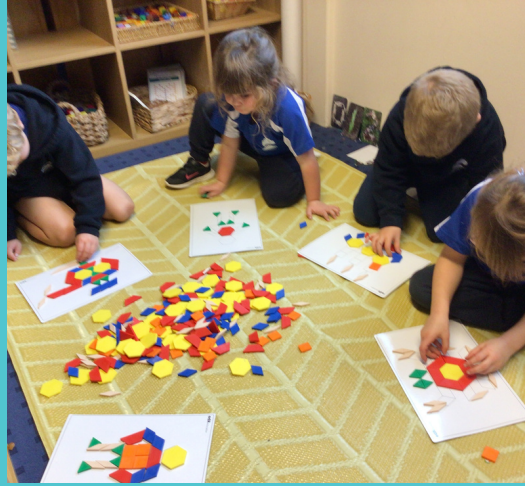
THANK YOU
